## Dear Campers:

Welcome back! Hope all is well and looking forward to seeing you. If you have moved or changed phone #'s please let us know. Opening day is Thursday, May 1<sup>st</sup> (weather permitting) and closing date is September 30th. All activities in the hall will commence May long weekend! All tarps and plywood to be removed before May long weekend. Deck enclosures in September NOT to begin until AFTER the seasonal party.

The seasonal fee this year is \$2900.00 (taxes incl.), plus power. A minimum payment of \$1,500.00 is due May 1<sup>st</sup> and the balance (minus deposit in 2024) by May 31. If you e-transfer please include your name and lot #. Our e-mail address **is** (riverlandcamp@aol.com). If full payment is made by Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> your name will be entered for a free lot draw to take place on Saturday, May 17th in the hall. Outstanding accounts on and after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be charged an additional \$50.00 and thereafter.

If you are selling your trailer the LOT FEE MUST BE PAID IN FULL on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>. The deposit is non-transferable to the new owner. Please phone the office to make sure your deck and shed meet with our requirements before you sell. Any trailer that is 25 years or older cannot be sold on a lot. A deposit of \$250.00 is required in September to hold your site for 2026.

Please be advised that if you relocate from one lot to another your lot has to be fixed up to the way you first moved in. If not, you will be charged a fee. This fee will be determined by the cleanup involved. Example: if you remove plants, patio stones, sheds etc.

**QUIET TIME** is **12:00 O'clock** midnight on Friday and Saturday nights and 10:00 p.m. Sunday to Thursday. There will be **ZERO TOLERANCE** for late night noise after quiet time. Please be considerate to your fellow campers. No excessively loud music during the day or night! No outdoor amplified music or karaoke machines. All children must be on their own site or area by **11:00 pm**, teenagers by **12:00am** on the weekend! You are responsible for the actions of your children and guests! **No Bicycles** to be driven after dark. No Driving of vehicles after 11:00pm. Please stay on the main road when walking, not between trailers!

Picnic tables and fire buckets are not provided Lawn mowers and gas is provided for mowing.

**DOGS** are to be tied up or kept on a leash at all times. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET**. No animal is allowed to travel on anyone elses' property. Please keep your dog on the main road when walking them. **No pit-bulls, rotweillers, german shepherds Dobermans allowed in the campground.** Dogs should not be left unattended outside or inside your trailer. Please control excessive barking from your dog! **DECKS** not to exceed total length 24'X 10' or 8 x 30, to be made in two sections. No deck can exceed the length of the trailer. Height of rail to be 36 inches from deck. All slides are to be incorporated in this measurement. Any new decks or alterations to existing decks must be approved by management in writing before construction begins. Plans & materials must be submitted. Rollershades are permitted but only 2, They can be installed on either end of your deck, or in a corner secured inside your deck and cannot exceed 8ft per shade. Only 2 shades down at a time.

**SHEDS** can only be 8'X 8' or smaller (no exceptions). All new sheds have to be made of plastic only! Please see management before purchase or installation. Wooden sheds in existence cannot be altered or relocated to another site. Sheds in poor condition must be torn down.

**TENTS** are not allowed to be put up on a seasonal site.

All visitors must park in the parking lot and **MUST REGISTER** with the office. All vehicles in the parking lot must display a **VISITORS PASS** in the window. The only vehicles permitted in the campground must belong to the owners of the trailer. Children with vehicles must park in the parking lot. Visitors (with the exception of moms, dads, grandparents and children) must pay to visit. The visitor fee for adults (19 and older) is \$6.00 whether you stay overnight or just visit for the day. You are responsible for the actions of your guests. There is no charge for children 18 and under. <u>NO</u> visitors cars allowed in the campground.

**ATV'S** must remain on your truck or trailer at all times. **No off-loading in the parking lot. NO** children's motorized, battery or electric powered vehicles are permitted in the park! No e-bikes as well. Scooters for mobility purposes are permitted.

**IMPORTANT**: Your gate pass is for your use only. They are not transferable to your children or friends. The fee for replacement cards is \$20.00. If you have 2 vehicles you need 2 gate passes. If you leave, your gate pass must be returned within that year or no refund will be given. The gate pass has to be in good condition for a refund. Please note we are not held responsible for any injury, theft, etc. that may occur in the campground. Swimming in the river or pool is at your own risk. All outstanding debts to be paid before you leave.
